



Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way that leadeth to destruction and many there be which to in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way which leadeth into life and few there be that find it. Matthew 7:13-14.

Matthew 25:34, 41, 46.

Heaven is for the righteous who decided to walk not after the flesh but after the spirit while Hell is for the natural man who did not accept Jesus Christ as his Lord and personal Saviour. And also for those who say they believe in Christ but are walking after the flesh. Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these: Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, sedition, heresies, envying, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. Galatians 5:19-21.

They are sweating profusely with all the church activities attending all the services and vigils, paying tithes and giving offerings, sowing seeds of faith, giving generously to the kingdom work, helping the needy. But they are actually running on the spot because they are still engaging in the works of the flesh which has tied them down refusing them to advance spiritually. Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers, of themselves with mankind, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, or extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. 1 Corinthians 6:9-10. Heaven is not for sinners or churchgoers but for those who have

decided and have given their lives to Jesus Christ and have accepted Him as their Lord and personal Saviour.

A man must consciously remove himself from the natural way of life because all men are born sinners: Behold, I was shapen in iniquity: and in sin did my mother conceive me. Psalms 51:5; for all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God. Roman 3:23. So a man must surrender to Jesus Christ in true holiness and righteousness, if not hell remains his final destination for all eternity. The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God. Psalms 9:17. Hell is for anyone that has abandoned the paths of righteousness to walk in the ways of ungodliness. Therefore, the Lord is saying to that man that is still separated from his Father by sin to come out and make the right decision to enter heaven. Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord; though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow, though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land. But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword; for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it. Isaiah 1:18-20. Nothing defiled shall enter into the kingdom of God.

Now that we are still alive, let us decide by our works where we will spend our eternity, Heaven or Hell. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad. 2 Corinthians 5:10.

The choice is yours, Heaven or Hell, choose wisely, eternity is too long to be forever separated from God. Choose you this day Heaven and live forever in paradise with God or Hell and be tormented forever.
